Our Work




Supply chain management of HIV/AIDS commodities (2018-2021)

This project, funded by Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria (GFATM), supported the National AIDS Control Organization's (NACO) response to the AIDS epidemic in India.

JSI partnered with Plan International (India Chapter) to help NACO and State AIDS Control Societies (SACS) ensure uninterrupted supply of high-quality anti-retroviral drugs, testing kits and other commodities across India. JSI also helped develop Standard Operating Procedures for Supply Chain Management of HIV/AIDS commodities.

In 2020, a technology-driven Learning Management System helped build capacity among personnel along the supply chain. The interactive content in the LMS increased motivation, reduced drop outs, improved sustainability and provided data on training coverage.

Supply Chain Management Strengthening (SCMS) project for HIV/AIDS and TB drugs (2021-2024)

The project helps NACO, Central TB Division (CTD), State AIDS Control Societies (SACS) and State TB Cells (STC) upgrade supply chains for high-quality ARVs, TB drugs, diagnostics and other commodities across India. JSI, as sub-recipient to Plan India, offers technical support to people, process and technology. We help strengthen regional and state supply chains under NACP and NTEP and collaborate with the Central TB Division (CTD) to revise Standard Operating Procedures. With a mix of face-to-face training and an electronic Learning Management System, we build capacity for 35,000 supply chain staff, across 48 State Drug Stores, 768 District Drug Stores, 6168 Tuberculosis Units and 38,000 Peripheral Health Institutes.

DAKSHATA Learning Management System:

Training **12,000** supply chain staff in **39** State AIDS Control Societies, **550** ARTCs and **6000** ICTCs for the National Aids Control Program (NACP)

JSI helps strengthen the electronic Logistics Management Information Systems (SOCH and Nikshay Aushadhi) under NACP and NTEP so that data can be recorded, reported and made visible in real time. This provides vital information to last mile facilities and helps them make better-informed decisions in time.
